
Luke 9:28-36 (NRSV)

²⁸Now about eight days after these sayings Jesus took with him Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. ²⁹And while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white. ³⁰Suddenly they saw two men, Moses and Elijah, talking to him. ³¹They appeared in glory and were speaking of his departure, which he was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. ³²Now Peter and his companions were weighed down with sleep; but since they had stayed awake, they saw his glory and the two men who stood with him. ³³Just as they were leaving him, Peter said to Jesus, 'Master, it is good for us to be here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah'—not knowing what he said. ³⁴While he was saying this, a cloud came and overshadowed them; and they were terrified as they entered the cloud. ³⁵Then from the cloud came a voice that said, 'This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!' ³⁶When the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. And they kept silent and in those days told no one any of the things they had seen.

²⁸ Como ocho días después de estas palabras, Jesús tomó a Pedro, a Juan y a Jacobo, y subió al monte a orar. ²⁹ Mientras oraba, la apariencia de su rostro cambió y su vestido se volvió blanco y resplandeciente. ³⁰ Y dos varones hablaban con él, los cuales eran Moisés y Elías. ³¹ Estos aparecieron rodeados de gloria; y hablaban de su partida, que Jesús iba a cumplir en Jerusalén. ³² Pedro y los que lo acompañaban estaban rendidos de sueño; pero, permaneciendo despiertos, vieron la gloria de Jesús y a los dos varones que estaban con él. ³³ Y sucedió que, mientras estos se alejaban de él, Pedro dijo a Jesús: —Maestro, bueno es para nosotros estar aquí. Hagamos tres enramadas, una para ti, una para Moisés y una para Elías. Pero no sabía lo que decía. ³⁴ Mientras él decía esto, vino una nube que los cubrió; y tuvieron temor al entrar en la nube. ³⁵ Y vino una voz desde la nube, que decía: «Éste es mi Hijo amado; a él oíd.» ³⁶ Cuando cesó la voz, Jesús se encontraba solo. Ellos callaron, y por aquellos días no dijeron nada a nadie de lo que habían visto.
