

Jesus Heals a Paralytic

When he returned to Capernaum after some days, it was reported that he was at home. ² So many gathered around that there was no longer room for them, not even in front of the door, and he was speaking the word to them. ³ Then some people came, bringing to him a paralyzed man, carried by four of them. 4 And when they could not bring him to Jesus because of the crowd, they removed the roof above him, and after having dug through it, they let down the mat on which the paralytic lay. 5 When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Child, your sins are forgiven." 6 Now some of the scribes were sitting there questioning in their hearts, 7 "Why does this fellow speak in this way? It is blasphemy! Who can forgive sins but God alone?" 8 At once Jesus perceived in his spirit that they were discussing these questions among themselves, and he said to them, "Why do you raise such questions in your hearts? 9 Which is easier: to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Stand up and take your mat and walk'? 10 But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins"—he said to the paralytic—11" I say to you, stand up, take your mat, and go to your home." 12 And he stood up and immediately took the mat and went out before all of them, so that they were all amazed and glorified God, saying, "We have never seen anything like this!"

Please take time for prayerful consideration as we discern together and seek guidance throughout the steps of the process.

The Process:

At present, there are three elders who are serving 3-year terms: Beth Sell (2025), Joseph Penner (2025), and Marj Mobley-Oorthuys (2025). We seek to add one elder to serve a 3-year term, as allowed by SMC bylaws and in accordance with our historical practice of having four elders.

On the back of this sheet is a nomination form to fill out and return by Sunday, February 11. The Discernment Committee will focus on the responses from the congregation along with the gifts identified for each person mentioned, and then continue the Discernment process.

The Qualifications:

The Pastoral Elders are responsible for the spiritual oversight of the congregation. Persons who are called to this office may demonstrate a variety of gifts including administration, counseling, teaching, and shepherding. Above all, they need to be persons who demonstrate good character, faith and spiritual wisdom.

No one person, of course, has all of the gifts mentioned above. Thus, the Pastoral Elders work as a team in such a way that their individual gifts complement each other. The gifts of Pastoral Elders are found in both men and women.

The Responsibilities:

Pastoral Elders are responsible to:

- foster vision and growth in the spiritual life of the congregation.
- assist in providing for the pastoral care needs of the congregation.
- facilitate the formation and functioning of small groups within the congregation.
- provide counsel for congregational education and training programs.
- serve in a supportive and advisory relationship to the pastor.
- be spiritual leaders, embodying the vision and faith of the congregation with an Anabaptist understanding.
