Isaiah 66:10-14 (NRSV)

- ¹⁰ Rejoice with Jerusalem, and be glad for her, all you who love her; rejoice with her in joy, all you who mourn over her—
- ¹¹ that you may nurse and be satisfied from her consoling breast; that you may drink deeply with delight from her glorious bosom.
- ¹² For thus says the Lord: I will extend prosperity to her like a river, and the wealth of the nations like an overflowing stream; and you shall nurse and be carried on her arm, and dandled on her knees.
- ¹³ As a mother comforts her child, so I will comfort you; you shall be comforted in Jerusalem.
- ¹⁴ You shall see, and your heart shall rejoice; your bodies shall flourish like the grass; and it shall be known that the hand of the Lord is with his servants, and his indignation is against his enemies.

Isaías 66:10-14 (RVR1995)

- ¹⁰ «Alegraos con Jerusalén, gozaos con ella todos los que la amáis; llenaos de gozo con ella todos los que os enlutáis por ella,
- ¹¹ para que maméis y os saciéis de los pechos de sus consolaciones, para que bebáis y os deleitéis con la plenitud de su gloria.»
- ¹² Porque así dice Jehová: «He aquí que yo extendiendo sobre ella la paz como un río y las riquezas de las naciones como un torrente que se desborda; y mamaréis, en los brazos seréis traídos y sobre las rodillas seréis mimados.
- ¹³ Como aquel a quien consuela su madre, así os consolaré yo a vosotros, y en Jerusalén recibiréis consuelo.»
- ¹⁴ Lo veréis y se alegrará vuestro corazón, y vuestros huesos reverdecen como la hierba. La mano de Jehová para con sus siervos se dará a conocer y se enojará contra sus enemigos.
