Galatians 3:23-29 (NRSV)

²³ Now before faith came, we were imprisoned and guarded under the law until faith would be revealed. ²⁴ Therefore the law was our disciplinarian until Christ came, so that we might be justified by faith. ²⁵ But now that faith has come, we are no longer subject to a disciplinarian, ²⁶ for in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith. ²⁷ As many of you as were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. ²⁸ There is no longer Jew or Greek, there is no longer slave or free, there is no longer male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹ And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to the promise.

²³ Pero antes que llegara la fe, estábamos confinados bajo la Ley, encerrados para aquella fe que iba a ser revelada. ²⁴ De manera que la Ley ha sido nuestro guía para llevarnos a Cristo, a fin de que fuéramos justificados por la fe. ²⁵ Pero ahora que ha venido la fe, ya no estamos bajo un guía, ²⁶ porque todos sois hijos de Dios por la fe en Cristo Jesús, ²⁷ pues todos los que habéis sido bautizados en Cristo, de Cristo estáis revestidos. ²⁸ Ya no hay judío ni griego; no hay esclavo ni libre; no hay hombre ni mujer, porque todos vosotros sois uno en Cristo Jesús. ²⁹ Y si vosotros sois de Cristo, ciertamente descendientes de Abraham sois, y herederos según la promesa.
