



1 Peter 5:1-14 (NRSV)

Now as an elder myself and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as one who shares in the glory to be revealed, I exhort the elders among you ²to tend the flock of God that is in your charge, exercising the oversight, not under compulsion but willingly, as God would have you do it-not for sordid gain but eagerly. ³Do not lord it over those in your charge, but be examples to the flock. ⁴And when the chief shepherd appears, you will win the crown of glory that never fades away. ⁵In the same way, you who are younger must accept the authority of the elders. And all of you must clothe yourselves with humility in your dealings with one another, for 'God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble.' ⁶ Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, so that he may exalt you in due time. 7Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you. ⁸Discipline yourselves; keep alert. Like a roaring lion your adversary the devil prowls around, looking for someone to devour. 9Resist him, steadfast in your faith, for you know that your brothers and sisters throughout the world are undergoing the same kinds of suffering. ¹⁰And after you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, support, strengthen, and establish you. ¹¹To him be the power for ever and ever. Amen. ¹² Through Silvanus, whom I consider a faithful brother, I have written this short letter to encourage you, and to testify that this is the true grace of God. Stand fast in it. ¹³Your sister church in Babylon, chosen together with you, sends you greetings; and so does my son Mark. ¹⁴Greet one another with a kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ.

- Mennonite World Conference has proposed changes to its "fair share" funding system that will impact Mennonite Church USA (MC USA) constituents. These proposed changes include an increase in the assessment of MC USA's fair share per person and no longer crediting denominations for direct donations from individuals. 1 Pedro 4:1-14 (RVR1995)

Ruego a los ancianos que están entre vosotros, yo, anciano también con ellos y testigo de los padecimientos de Cristo, que soy también participante de la gloria que será revelada: ² apacentad la grey de Dios que está entre vosotros, cuidando de ella, no por fuerza, sino voluntariamente; no por ganancia deshonesta, sino con ánimo pronto; ³ no como teniendo señorío sobre los que están a vuestro cuidado, sino siendo ejemplos de la grey. ⁴ Y cuando aparezca el Príncipe de los pastores, vosotros recibiréis la corona incorruptible de gloria. 5 Igualmente, jóvenes, estad sujetos a los ancianos; y todos, sumisos unos a otros, revestíos de humildad, porque «Dios resiste a los soberbios, y da gracia a los humildes.» ⁶Humillaos, pues, bajo la poderosa mano de Dios, para que él os exalte a su debido tiempo. ⁷ Echad toda vuestra ansiedad sobre él, porque él tiene cuidado de vosotros. 8 Sed sobrios y velad, porque vuestro adversario el diablo, como león rugiente, anda alrededor buscando a quien devorar.⁹ Resistidlo firmes en la fe, sabiendo que los mismos padecimientos se van cumpliendo en vuestros hermanos en todo el mundo. ¹⁰ Pero el Dios de toda gracia, que nos llamó a su gloria eterna en Jesucristo, después que haváis padecido un poco de tiempo, él mismo os perfeccione, afirme, fortalezca y establezca. ¹¹ A él sea la gloria y el imperio por los siglos de los siglos.
